3 yards of Focus Fabric

Fold fabric lengthwise 108 X 45, Cut 8- 5" strips

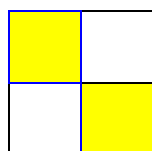
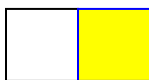
Set aside 4 of these strips for the borders.



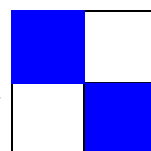
1 yard of 2 contrasting fabrics

From each of the 1 yd. pieces cut 6-5" strips WOF

Strip piece method: take 5X108 focus sub cut to 8-5X45, 2- 5"X 18". Next sew the strips of the 1 yard cut with Focus 5X45 sub cutting them into 42-5" each set.



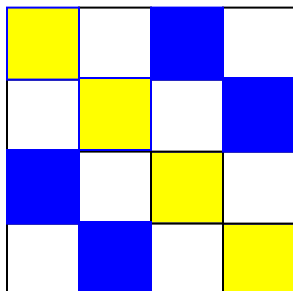

Sew 2 sets of 4-patches

Put the 4 patches together into nine 16-patch sq.



Set aside 3 of each 4 patch sq.

These 16 patches will be set

3 across and 3 down

Taking the remainder 4 patches

Use them for the last row.

Option 1 - Finish the quilt by putting on the 5" border, you would even have enough fabric to miter corners. Use Focus Fabric for binding, cut 2 1/2" strips. Approximate size 63" X 72"

Option 2 - If you add a 2.5 border before the outer border, preferably a darker one to frame in the quilt. 67" X 76" This is a cute, quick quilt. (2.5 hours!)
